**Write an essay on one of the topics suggested:**

1. What is a white lie? Do you think it is OK to tell white lies? Don't you think that a number of white lies just grow into a pack of lies and you get used to it? Why is it dangerous? Remember the last time you told a white lie to a friend, a family member or a teacher. Do you think the situation was worth telling the lie? Is exaggeration the same as lying in your opinion?
